Beaune, Burgundy

Red wine from France

Drinking window: 2019 - 2025

Bright medium red. High-toned aromas of red fruits and red licorice, plus a faint weedy quality. Tight and a bit dry, with the bitter cherry flavor showing modest texture and sweetness. Finishes with building, edgy tannins, a suggestion of bitter chocolate and a slightly rustic quality. This will need time to unwind but will it ever really expand in bottle? (Morot's Savigny-lès-Beaune La Bataillère aux Vergelesses was pliant and supple but a bit too *sauvage* for me.)
