Moderately saturated dark red with ruby highlights. Distinctly meaty scents of ripe raspberry and game are more Gevrey than Beaune in character. Fat, pliant and concentrated if a touch rustic and leathery. With aeration, this wine showed its typical power and depth but remained quite wild. Finishes with excellent length. I'd love to taste this again in five or six years.
