The Plot

Surface area : 0,25 ha
Grape variety : Chardonnay
Sol : Stony, rich in loams and clays
Exposure : East
Location : mid-slope
Planting density : 10 000 vines/ha
Planting year : 1988

Vine growing

Pruned using a soft "Guyot" method
Soil worked by mounding and unmounding, then ploughed
Biological protection

Harvesting

100% Hand picked, using small cases of 15kg.
Careful sorting out in the vineyard and winery.

Vinification

Whole-cluster pressing, clarification, then racked in barrel
Fermentation in 350 l. French oak barrels
Natural yeasts only
Stirring of the lees if necessary

Ageing

14 months in 350 l. French oak barrels.
Slow malolactic fermentation
No racking

Bottling

By gravity, with no fining or filtering

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
