### The Plot

#### Lieu-dit : En vergelesses

Surface area : 1.20 ha

Grape variety : Pinot Noir

Sol : Sandy limestone

Exposure : South / South-east

Location : mid-slope

Planting density : 10 000 vines/ha

Planting year: : 1971 – 1990 - 1999

### Vine growing

Pruned using a soft "Guyot" method

Soil worked by mounding and unmounding, then ploughed

Biological protection

### Harvesting

100% Hand picked, using small cases of 15kg.

Careful sorting out in the vineyard and winery.

### Vinification

Traditional method in open vats, with partially de-stemmed grapes

Natural yeasts only

Daily pumping.

### Ageing

14 to 18 months in French oak barrels.

Slow malolactic fermentation

No racking

### Bottling

By gravity, with no fining or filtering

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
