**Domaine Albert Morot 2014 Beaune Bressandes 1er Cru**

**Beaune, Burgundy**

**Red wine from France**

**Drinking window: 2020 - 2030**

Bright, dark red. Aromas of black cherry, licorice and sweet spices suggest a softer palate than the Toussaints or Cent-Vignes. Nicely ripe and plush in the mouth, with wild red berry flavors complicated but not overshadowed by a leathery nuance. Offers good texture and subtle sweetness. Here the tannins are ripe and nicely enrobed by the wine's material.
